

GUIDELINES FOR ABSTRACT SUBMISSION

POSTER/ ORAL/ SYMPOSIUM PRESENTATION GUIDELINES

General guidelines (Poster/Oral)

- All abstracts related to **Psychosocial Oncology** are eligible for submission.
- Only registered participants can submit the abstracts.
- **Only one** author can do oral or poster presentation and the presenting author only will receive the certificate.
- Individuals can submit a maximum of two abstracts as the presenting author.
- There is no separate abstract submission fee.
- Mention the presenting author's full name, educational qualification, designation, institution, conference registration number and mobile number (whatsapp) in the email while submitting the abstract.
- Completed abstracts must be submitted through the mail psychooncologymcc@gmail.com with the subject Abstract for MINDCAN 2025.
- Please submit your abstract on or before **1st October 2025 (Wednesday) 5.00pm**.
- Corresponding author will be notified via email regarding the allotted presentation mode and guidelines for presentation before **October 20th, 2025**.

Abstract specific Guidelines

- All abstracts related to Psychosocial Oncology only are eligible for submission.
- Abstract has not been presented or accepted for publication previously.
- Structured abstract must not be more than 300 words (excluding Title & author names).
- The abstract should include: Title, Author names with affiliation, Background, Material and Methods, Result and Discussion, Conclusion and Implications of the study.
- Those abstracts not in proper format and without relevant information will be returned to the concerned for modifications.
- Authors may provide their preference of presentation format: Oral/poster/no preference
- However, if many more abstracts are submitted for oral presentations than there are available slots within the programme, the Scientific Committee will decide which submissions to include as oral or poster presentations.
- The decision of the Scientific Committee will be final
- Abstract will be reviewed by the abstract review committee based on
 1. Scientific merit
 2. Topic relevance
 3. Methodological rigor
 4. Data analysis and Conclusion
 5. Overall quality and clarity
 6. Implications of the study

Symposium Guidelines

- Topic must be related to **Psycho-social intervention in cancer trajectory**.
- Symposium should include three presenters and one moderator.
- The presenters' topics of presentation should be inter-related.

- The presenters' abstracts can be combined together to form a single abstract mentioning moderator's and presenters name and affiliation.
- The consolidated symposium abstract can be submitted by the moderator to psychooncologymcc@gmail.com with the subject Symposium Abstract for MINDCAN 2025.
- Maximum 25 minutes of podium presentation will be allotted, approximately 3 min for introduction (moderator), 6 minutes for each presenter, 2 minutes conclusion (moderator) and 2 minute for discussion.
